Kingdom. If there is a kingdom, then there is also a king. The question is, "Who is really in control?" The king who is sitting on his throne has the authority to issue edicts and commands that he rightfully expects the residents of his land to follow. It is not a question of public opinion and approval – a king does not need the public to approve of his decisions. He does not have to gain authority to make decisions and set the course for his reign. He has this because he is king.

What is our King saying to us? Do we approach is commands with the notion that they are merely suggestions that we may opt in to or choose to ignore? Do we consider his commands a buffet that we can pick and choose what we want to put on our plate? We know the answer. He expects us to not just say we love him, but to pursue his agenda actively, and consistently above all else, and to live in a way that proves the gospel really does make a difference in this life. Two statements of Jesus come to mind:

"Seek the kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need" (Matthew 6. 33 NLT).

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me" (Matthew 16. 24).

As Dr. Tony Evans said in his excellent book, <u>Oneness Embraced</u>, "The kingdom agenda is the visible manifestation of the comprehensive rule of God over every area of life." There is, therefore, no area of my life...or yours...where Jesus does not have the absolute right and authority to implement his agenda. He is Lord of all of me, or he is Lord of none of me. The working out of his kingdom in my life has internal and external consequences. Internally, it is transforming who I am. Externally, it is transforming how I live.

As we move forward, pursuing his kingdom with all our hearts, souls, minds, and strength, we will experience his presence, peace, and power in ways we did not anticipate. We will be challenged beyond what we believe is reasonable and moved to live radically in Christ Jesus. As Dr. Evans also shared in an illustration of a shoemaker whose residence was above his shop, "My home is up there, but my work is down here."

It is time to go to work.
